METHOD OF SELECTION

- 1. Schuyler County graduating high school seniors are invited to apply for a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship from the Watkins-Montour Rotary Club.
- 2. Applications will be screened and selected by a committee of at least four Watkins-Montour Rotarians.
- 3. Scoring Basis:
 - A. Service Above Self 40%
 - B. Extracurricular Activities 30%
 - C. Academic 20%
 - D. Educational Goals 10%
- 4. Recipients must be willing to join Rotarians at a regular meeting to be recognized by the Club.
- 5. The scholarship will be awarded at the start of the second semester and after the student submits a first-semester transcript that shows a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- 6. Deadline for all materials to be submitted: May 24, 2024.
